### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Class rules apply, 29er Finnish National Championship addendum apply
- 1.3 Racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - RRS 61.1 (a) Boat must record intention of protest and target of the protest immediately after finishing the race.
- 1.4 Rule G3 is subject to Race committee's permission
- 1.5 In case of conflict of between languages, English version will prevail.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to boats of the Snipe, F18, Europe, Zoom 8 and 29er (Finnish National Championships) classes.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter the event by registering online at [EMK Syysregatta 2022 manage2sail](#)
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete the online registration and pay the registration fee.

### 5 ENTRY FEE

- 5.1 The entry fees are

per boat, subject to be paid upon registration in Manage2sail. Possible after-sail meal packages can be purchased as separate item (10-15€/day/sailor) during the finalization of entry.

## 6 ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

## 7 SCHEDULE

### 7.1 Registration

Sailors must self-register via the manage2sail portal following organizers notification of self-registering being opened. By registering, sailor acknowledges compliance to the requirements on insurance and any other class specific requirements. Should class rules require submission of e.g. boat details, these must be sent by email to [syysregatta@emk.fi](mailto:syysregatta@emk.fi) by the closing of the registration.

- 7.3 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15:00.

## 8 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 Boats may be inspected at any time.

## 9 VENUE

- 9.1 NoR Addendum A shows the plan of the event venue.  
9.2 NoR Addendum B shows the location of the racing areas. Primarily racing will take place on race areas K and I, area A being reserve area. Class-specific racing areas are defined in Sailing Instructions.

## 10 COURSES

- 10.1 Races will be windward/leeward races with spreader bouys.  
10.2 Description of the course will be in the Sailing Instructions.

## 11 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 Appendix P is changed as follows (applying to all classes):

- P2.1 First Penalty

When a boat is first penalized under rule P1.2 her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty under rule 44.2. If she fails to take it, she shall be disqualified without a hearing.

- P2.2 Second and Subsequent Penalties  
When a boat is penalized a third or subsequent time during the event, she shall promptly retire. If she does so her penalty shall be disqualification without a hearing and her score shall not be excluded. This will change rules P2.2 ja P2.3.

## **12 SCORING**

- 12.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.3 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **13 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS**

- 13.1 Support person vessels shall be registered in Manage2sail in class "coach" latest at 9.9.
- 13.2 Support person vessels are required to act as safety boats as instructed by the Race committee.

## **14 MEDIA RIGHTS**

- 14.1 Competitors, owners and their guests give absolute right and permission to the Organizing Authority for any photography and video footage taken of persons and boats during the event, to be published and/or broadcast in any media, including but not limited to TV advertisements, whatsoever for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information.

## **13 RISK STATEMENT**

- 13.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes. The Organizing Authority and any other party involved in the organization of the event disclaim any and all responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and materials, both ashore and at sea as a consequence of participation in the event. Each boat owner or his representative accepts these terms by completing entry form.

## **14 INSURANCE**

- 14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of 150 000€ per incident or equivalent. Insurance certificate must be presented when requested, or in case class rules require so, provided to the organizer in electronic form during the registration.

## **15 PRIZES**

- 15.1 Prizes will be given to first three boats in each class. Finnish National Championship medals will be provided to eligible sailors in 29er class.


